

We're excited for you to share the at-home SNS experience. Doing your own dip powder nails will be fun and satisfying, as long as you follow the simple instructions here. For your first manicure, take your time! Look carefully at each instruction and follow it carefully. You'll soon get to know the process and then your manicures will go much faster.

### **Nail Prep Instructions:**

How to Prep Your Nails for a n SNS Manicure For best results, please read all the instructions before starting. Make sure to have a lint-free paper towel ready.



Remove any previously applied nail products. Unsure how to do this? No problem. Turn the page to see a basic primer on safe removal.



Trim nails, then file to desired shape. A slightly rounded nail shape or square-rounded edge is generally recommended, but you can be as creative as you want.



(Optional Step) Soak your hands in warm water with mild soap. We recommend facial soap rather than hand soap to prevent your hands from becoming too dry.



Using the cuticle pusher, gently push back the cuticles. Don't push the cuticle too far because it can damage nail growth or fray the cuticle. Be careful NOT to pull, lift, tear, rip, force, or cut into the cuticle in any way.



(Optional Step) Using the **Buffer**, lightly buff nails to create an even surface.



Use a **Nail Prep Pad** to remove any residue or oil from the nail.

### **French Manicure Dip Powder Instructions:**



Working one hand at a time, apply a thin layer of **Dip Base Coat (Purple Cap)** to 3/4 of the nail then immediately dip the nail into **Foundation Powder** at a 45-degree angle. Tap finger, then move on to the next nail. Once all the nails have been dipped, use the Dip Powder **Dust Brush** to dust off excess powder around the nail and fingertips.

Add a second layer by using the Dip Base Coat and Foundation Powder as described in Step 1. Apply the **Dip Base Coat** up to but not over the cuticle line.



Apply another thin layer of Dip Base Coat, staying 2mm away from the cuticle.





Dip the entire nail into Soft Pink Powder, tap finger, then use Dip Powder Brush to gently dust off excess powder around the nail. Repeat the process on your other nails.



Apply another thin layer of Dip Base Coat staving 2mm away from the cuticle.



Using the **French Manicure Mold**, dip the tip of the fingernail into Classic White Powder to create the French tip smile line. Then dip into **Soft Pink Powder** and tap finger. Then use the **Dip Powder Brush** to gently dust off excess around the nail. Repeat the process on your other nails.



Apply Dip Activator (Grav Cap) to the entire nail. The **Activator** will penetrate through the dip powder, which will activate its hardening process. Before placing the brush back into the **Dip Activator**, wipe on a lint-free paper towel, to prevent any color powder from getting into the **Dip Activator**.



Wait 4 minutes for the **Dip Activator** to dry completely. You can test this by lightly tapping the end of the **Dust Brush** on the nail surface. If you hear a click sound, that indicates that the nail is dry.



Carefully shape and buff to smooth out any bumps or ridges and get a beautiful, even surface. Use the nail file to trace along the cuticle line to get a clean outer border. Use the **Dust Brush** to gently dust off excess powder.



Rinse and dry hands, with water only, NO SOAP.



Apply a second coat of **Dip Activator**, wait 3 minutes or until completely dry. Before placing the brush back into **Dip Activator**, wipe off excess on a paper towel.



Brush a thin layer of **Dip Top Coat** (Red Cap) onto the entire nail, making sure to seal the nail edge. Wait 3 minutes, or until the nail is completely dry.



Apply a second layer of Dip Top Coat to the nail and wait for it to completely dry.




Apply Signature Serum (Yellow Cap) to the cuticle and massage gently.

### **Color Dip Powder Instructions:**



Working one hand at a time, apply a thin layer of Dip Base Coat (Purple Cap) to ¾ of the nail then immediately dip the nail into **Foundation Powder** at a 45-degree angle. Tap finger, then move on to the next nail. Once all the nails have been dipped, use the Dip Powder **Dust Brush** to dust off excess powder around the nail and fingertips





Apply a thin layer of Dip Base Coat, staying 2mm away from the cuticle. Apply the **Dip Base Coat** up to but not over the cuticle line.



Dip the nail into the jar of Color Powder at a 45-degree angle all the way up to the cuticle line. Repeat the application process on your other nails. Use the **Dust Brush** to dust off excess powder.



Apply a second layer of **Dip Base Coat** and Color Powder, using the process described in Step 3 & 4.



Apply Dip Activator (Gray Cap) to the entire nail. The Activator will penetrate through the dip powder, which will activate its hardening process. Before placing the brush back into the Dip Activator, wipe on a lint-free paper towel, to prevent any color powder from getting into the **Dip Activator**.



Wait 4 minutes for the **Dip Activator** to dry completely. You can test this by lightly tapping the end of the **Dust** Brush on the nail surface. If you hear a click sound, that indicates that the nail



Apply a second coat of **Dip Activator** (Gray Cap), wait 3 minutes or until completely dry. \*Before placing the brush back into the Dip Activator, wipe off excess on a paper towel.



Brush a thin layer of **Dip Top Coat** (Red Cap) onto the entire nail, making sure to seal the free edge of the nail. Wait 3 minutes, or until the nail is completely dry.





Apply Signature Serum (Yellow Cap) to the cuticle and massage gently.

### **Removal Instructions**

#### **Removing Dip Powder**

What you need to get started: SNS Healthy Removal Bundle or SNS Soak Off Solution, cotton wool, foil squares, nail file and Signature Serum.

- Trim nails to desired length.
- Carefully buff off shine, making sure not to touch the natural nail with the file.
- Optional: cover cuticles with **Signature Serum**.
- Wrap each finger in acetone soaked cotton wool, covered with foil. We recommend double foil wrapping to trap in more heat. This will activate the toner and prevent the acetone from leaking out of the foil.
- Allow to soak off for 10 minutes. rewrap and check every 5 minutes. Use the cotton wool and rub the nails in a circular motion. The old nail product should be soft and sticky but should remove easily when rubbed off with light pressure. Do not force, pick or pry off the old product. Doing so can cause damage to the nail.
- Optional: Massage Signature **Serum** gently into nails and cuticles.
